Schools as Collaborative Cultures: Creating the Future Now (School Development and the Management of Change Series)



Teacher collaboration is a key activity in the developing school. The contributions offered here provide a set of improvisations on the same theme; that each school needs to establish a collaborative culture as a pre condition for its own development. Associated themes touched upon here include bureaucratic schooling, democratic leadership, teacher professionalism and teacher involvement in decision - making colleagueship. Common running through the collection include - the creation of community in schools, the struggle to understand and develop the use ideas of such as commitment, colleagueship and leadership, and the desire to rethink fundamentally how schools can change.
