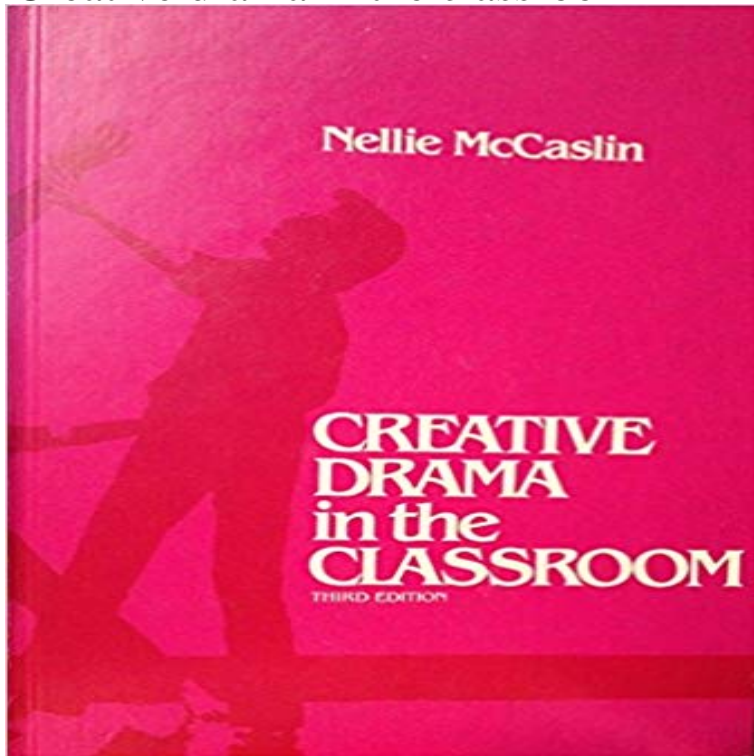


## Creative drama in the classroom
