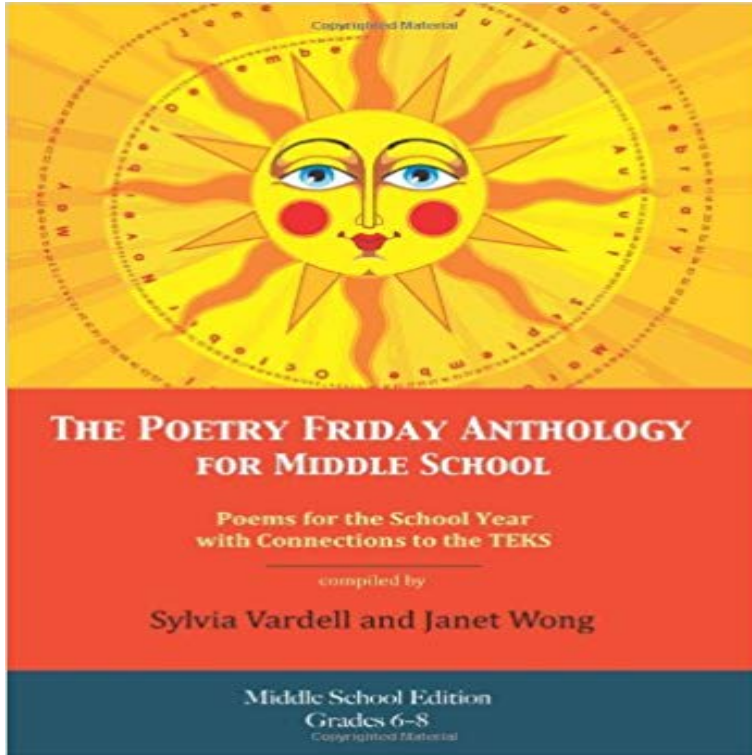


The Poetry Friday Anthology for Middle School (grades 6-8), Texas TEKS Edition: Poems for the School Year with Connections to the TEKS
