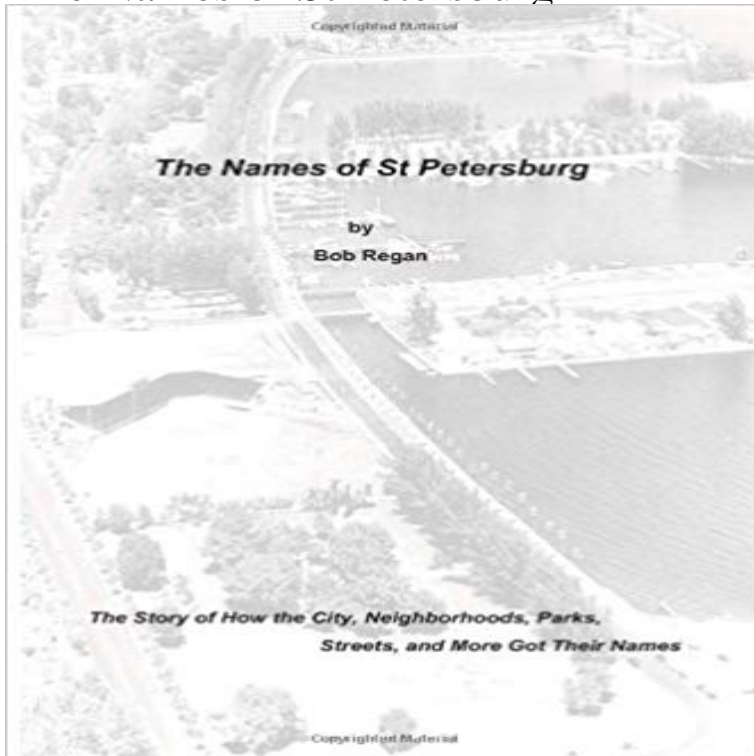


The Names of St Petersburg
